



INAPPROPRIATE BEHAVIOUR

G.Beatz Nightclub is a safe nightclub environment exclusive for adults with disabilities. Our team of volunteers, along with the team of bar staff (provided by GFC) work hard to ensure this space stays safe and exclusive for service users.

Behaviour deemed as inappropriate:

- Unkind/abusive language to other service users/volunteers/staff.
- Pushing/shoving/hitting.
- Sexualised behaviours.
- Consistent complaints from other service users/support workers/volunteers.
- Excessive alcohol consumption.
- Not leaving the premises at closing time or when asked to.
- Not following guidance from G.Beatz volunteers or GFC staff.

This list is not exhaustive.

If any of the inappropriate behaviour above, takes place, G.Beatz Nightclub will follow this process below:

1. Verbal warning to the service user(s) and carers (if in attendance).
2. If behaviour continues after the warning, we will ask the service user to leave the event.
3. If the service user wishes to return, they will be asked to bring a support worker/carer with them to future events.
4. If they are unable to attend the events with a support worker/carer, we will refuse entry to the event.

However, if the behaviour is posing a severe risk to other service users/volunteers/staff, the service user will be asked to leave the event immediately and will be unable to return to any G.Beatz Nightclub events in the future.

Depending on the situation and risks involved, G.Beatz may be forced to call the police who will deal with the situation further.
