



SERVICE USERS WITHOUT SUPPORT

This document details G.Beatz Nightclub's policies for service users attending G.Beatz Nightclub CIC and other events/classes organised by G.Beatz Nightclub CIC.

It is a choice to attend G.Beatz Nightclub CIC and other events/classes organised by G.Beatz Nightclub CIC with or without a support worker/carer. We advise attendees to attend with a carer if their support needs or mental capacity requires this level of support.

G.Beatz Nightclub CIC is an event exclusive for adults over the age of 18 with a disability. If the service users do not have a disability, this event is not appropriate for them.

Those attending without support are deemed to:

- Have mental capacity to make decisions/choices.
- Have mental capacity to keep themselves safe.
- Manage own money.
- Manage their personal requirements independently (e.g., toileting).
- Organise their own transport to and from the event.
- Manage healthy relationships with friends/peers.
- Manage appropriate behaviour.
- Manage timekeeping (start & finish times).
- Follow rules/guidance.

Our team of volunteers are there to ensure the event is a safe space for all attending. G.Beatz volunteers are not there to provide any level of support.

All volunteers have a DBS check and have undertaken Safeguarding training.

They can signpost service users to the appropriate service if they require any further help or support.

We reserve the right to refuse entry if we believe the service user requires support at our event, as they are not managing well independently.
